

Race letter for the Castle Combe Midweek 10k Wednesday 13th July 2022

It's almost time for the Castle Combe Midweek 10k at Castle Combe with **DB Max**.

This race letter includes all the details for race day at this superb, traffic-free venue.


Race Venue

The race venue is Castle Combe Race Circuit, for directions to the venue, please [click here](#). The postcode for Sat Navs is SN14 7EY.

On arriving at the venue follow the signs to the DB Max Car Park and please use the **Westway Entrance** and park as directed by the attendants. Access to the venue will be from 17:15. Please **DO NOT** use the Competitors Entrance.

Car Parking

On arrival, ample free parking is available in. Please ensure you allow ample space between cars. Please follow instructions from the parking attendants and then follow the signs to the start area.



Registration

Race numbers and timing chips will be collected from the registration desk on the day of the event. Registration will be open from 17:45 to 19:00. Please attach your race number to your front while racing so that it can be clearly seen - race belts may be used if required.

Please note that bibs, chips, race lists and all literature have gone to print, and no transfers, refunds or deferrals are available at this stage.

About your timing chip

Runners: Your timing chip is attached to your race bib. Please attach the bib as per the video [HERE](#). Runners do not need to return timing chips after the run.

The timing chips will ensure that your finish results (as well as splits and lap times) are collected by the system.

Remember, no timing chip, no results.

We ask that all competitors fill in the back of their race bib with their emergency information. This information is invaluable in an emergency. It takes just a minute to fill it in and helps the medics in the event of an incident.

Mandatory Pre-Race Briefing

There will be a pre-race briefing at Race HQ 10 minutes before race start. Please also read this race letter thoroughly and follow marshal instructions and signage on race day.

Start Time

19:15

Run Route

The race starts in a new location on the service road near Tower Corner, competitors then turn on to the circuit at the chicane and then complete 3.4 laps in a clockwise direction.



Finish

When you are approaching the finish of your event, please bear left into the chicane and finish under the arch.

Once you cross the line you will be able to collect your medal. Please note that we are trailing a new medal at this event which is a zero to landfill medal made of recycled material and can be recycled by you as well.

Spectators

Spectators are permitted at this event. Dogs are also permitted, but must be kept on a lead at all times and any mess cleaned up.

Water Station

There will be 1 water station on route which you will pass on each lap, this will be opposite the finish line. If you do need to use a water station, then you must follow marshal instructions. When you have finished you **MUST** place the cup in the bins provided as you are not permitted to run with the cup.

Cut Offs

There is no official cut-off for the event, however you will be expected to complete the event in less than 1 hour 25 minutes in total. In the unlikely event that an event manager deems that you are not fit to continue they will remove you from the event.

Litter

Littering is obviously not acceptable at any time. If you use gels you must return to the finish with the wrappers and take your litter home with you, if you can carry a full gel, you can certainly carry an empty one. Littering incurs immediate disqualification.

Race Photography

[Charles Whiton Photography](#) will be on site taking photos from the day. These are available to buy after the event. Please feel free to smile for the camera and make sure your race bib is clearly visible. You will be able to view your photos on your individual results page once the photographer has uploaded them to his site. The bib recognition means you can access your own photos quickly and easily.

Coffee/Hot Drinks

Hot drinks will be available from the Coffee Lada in the race HQ area, in a Covid safe manner.

iPods and MP3 Players

Competitors are permitted to wear iPods or MP3 players while they are racing, please ensure that volumes are kept to a level where you can hear marshals' instructions.

DB Max Sports Timing

DB Max Sports Timing will be producing the race results including splits and laps. You can follow the results live on the day at dbmaxresults.co.uk via your smart phones.

Pacers

There will be pacers at this event with the following times.

38/40/42/45/48/50/52/55/58/60/62/65/70/75 minutes. Pacers will be identifiable from the flags they will be wearing.

Toilets

Toilets will be available for all competitors in the car park before heading to the start.. When using the toilets please use the hand sanitiser provided before entering, then wipe the toilet down after use with the disinfectant wipes and flush them away. When leaving the toilet please ensure you again sanitise your hands. No showers are available at the event.

Bag Drop

There is no bag drop available at this event. Race HQ is right next to the car park, so please leave all valuables and bags in your car.

Marshals

As with all DB Max races we could not hold the event without the help of all the marshals. Please thank them where possible. Marshals receive a free entry to a future DB Max event. If you are interested in marshalling, please email james@dbmax.co.uk.
